Regional Medical Laboratory is pleased to announce an upcoming modification to the reference range for red blood cells present in urinary sediment, as identified during a urinalysis microscopic examination.

The American Urological Association provides guidelines for the presence of asymptomatic microscopic hematuria (AMH) as having 3 or more red blood cells (RBC) per high power field (HPF) on a microscopic examination of urinary sediment. To best align with this guideline, RML is adjusting the reference range.

Old Reference Range	New Reference Range
0-5 RBC/HPF	0-2 RBC/HPF

This change will be effective September 25, 2019. Updated reference ranges will post alongside patient results on both paper and electronic charts.
